The SPCA of Luzerne County will be limiting public access to our shelter until further notice.

Due to the current situation regarding the COVID 19 virus we will be making every effort to protect our community, in accordance with health professionals' guidance and Governor Tom Wolf's recommendations. The following procedures will be implemented starting Wednesday, March 18, 2020 and continue until further notice in order to protect our animals, staff and community. Such actions will allow us to continue to offer the services our community has come to expect and depend upon with some minor exceptions.

- The animals will continue to receive the same level of care, love and treatment by our dedicated staff.
- We will not be holding any open visiting hours. All public interactions inside the shelter will be done by appointment only. The SPCA staff will be diligently working to make sure that all of our animals' photos will be available on all our social media pages. If you are interested in an animal that you see on our website or Facebook page, our adoption staff will be available for further information and questions you may have. You may either e-mail your adoption application to adoptions@luzernespca.org, fax it to 570-825-7898 or by regular mail. - We will not be selling any dog licenses at this time. You may secure a dog license online at www.padoglicense.com
- We will continue to honor surrender appointments.
- We will also continue to service stray, injured animals and/or emergency situations that develop.
- Please note that while we appreciate all that our volunteers do for us we will be suspending our Volunteer Program until further notice. All outside adoption events will also be canceled until further notice, so as not to encourage unnecessary social gathering.

For 63 years Your SPCA has been able to serve the needs of our community and provide care for the abandoned, abused and neglected animals because of the generosity and love of the community we serve.
